- 5. There will be long drive and closest to the pin contests for everyone to test their skills!
- 6. Turn in your scorecard when you've finished and join your neighbors for the awards presentation!
- 7. If things go wrong, putts aren't falling, refer to rule #1
- 8. No complaining (again, see rule #1).

The entry fee is \$30 per golfer, which includes golf, power cart (mandatory) lunch afterwards at the Clubhouse, and of course, prizes for the winners! Awards ceremony will be at 2:00 PM.
