Golf Joke of the Month:

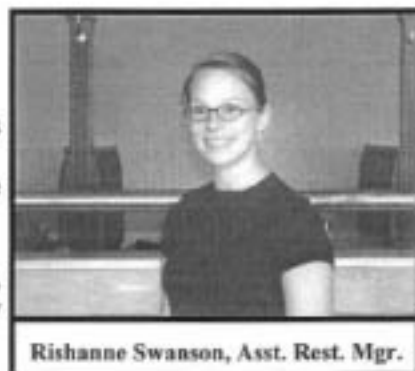
Arnold Palmer and Tiger Woods are playing together on the 16th hole when Tiger's tee shot lands behind a huge, 100-foot fir tree.
