Golf Tip Of the Month:

An important shot to have in the golf bag is a punch shot. There are times when you need to hit the ball low and keep it under the wind or you have to hit the ball under a tree and need to get the ball back into play. The punch shot comes in handy. Basically, you play a punch shot by positioning the ball back in your stance and moving your hands a bit forward at address. This de-lofts the golf club which keeps the trajectory of the ball lower. Your wrists need to be firm as you swing through the ball and you want to strike downward on the back of the golf ball. When you practice, try playing the ball back in your stance and hit down on the ball. Start out with half swings at first and see how low you can make the trajectory of the ball. This is a great trouble shot which every player should learn how to hit.
